Basketball Singlet Collection

- Step 5:** Select your child that you are purchasing the shirt for
- Step 6:** Scroll down to find Basketball Shirt and click to purchase
- Step 7:** **Collect your singlet from the sports office during breaks 1 or 2 before Round 1**

AIC Cross Country Lead up meets

Ideally every runner should attend the 1st meet this weekend, as it is at Limestone Park, the location for the AIC championships and an excellent practice race.

- 1:30pm – Warm ups
- 2:00pm – Year 5
- 2:15pm – Year 6

- 2:50pm – 14/15yrs
- 3:10pm – 16yrs/open
- 4:30pm – Bus arrives back at MCA

All runners are required to wear their cross country singlet and running shorts during the race. To promote our team culture and represent our college, all boys are highly encouraged to wear the XC cap and socks (these can be purchased on QKR or in cash from Mr Boles), as well as the long sleeve cross country shirt from previous XC seasons to and from the meets. Confraternity Carnival 2017

During the first week of the holidays, our Open Rugby League Team competed in the Confraternity Carnival held at Padua Playing Fields, Banyo. The carnival brings together 960 of the state's premier independent school students plus over 200 staff volunteers as coaching and support staff. In addition, over 5000 parents, family and spectators attended this year's carnival. The Confraternity Carnival has been in existence since 1980 and in that time, has developed a reputation as one of the most formidable schoolboy rugby league competitions in Australia.

After last year's success in Division 2, our Open Rugby League Team moved up to Division 1 at this year's carnival, which ultimately placed us in the Top 16 Independent Rugby League playing schools within the state. This was always going to be a challenge, but one we embraced wholeheartedly.

Below is an overview of our results throughout the tournament (Man of the Match (MoM) is awarded by an independent selector who conducts a presentation with both teams at the conclusion of the game):

Game 3 – 44-0 win against St Augustine's, Cairns – [MoM – Kale Van Dugteren]

Game 4 (QF) – 12-10 loss to Emmaus College, Rockhampton [MoM – Shaun Anderson]

Game 5 – 36-6 win against St Teresa's College, Abergowrie [MoM - Shaun Anderson]

Game 6 – 44-0 win against St Edmund's College, Ipswich [MoM - Shaun Anderson]

Marist College Ashgrove Best & Fairest Player – Shaun Anderson

Marist College Ashgrove Spirit Award – Tom Carroll

Based on these results we were placed 13th out of the 48 schools who attended. Special thanks to all the parents and supporters who came out and supported the team throughout the week.

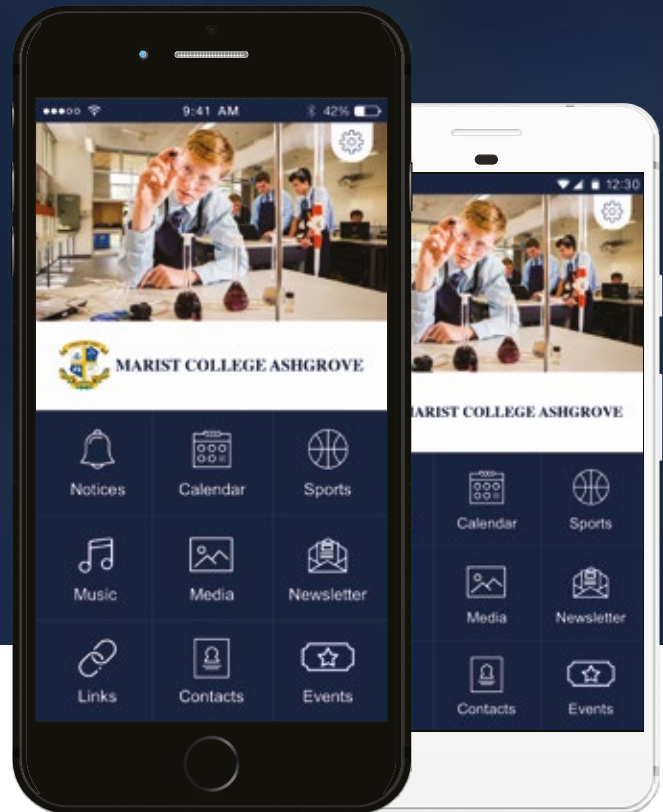
